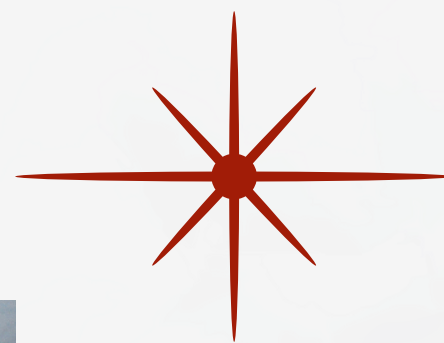

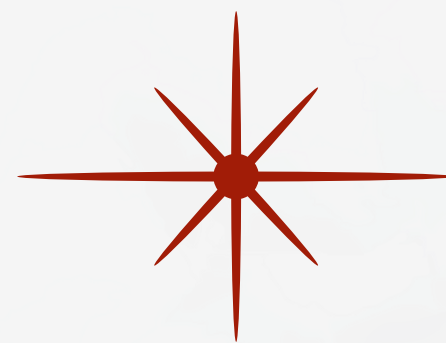

# India's New Curriculum

Artificial intelligence and computational thinking will be part of curriculum from Class 3 onwards, in line with the National Education Policy, 2020. Along with technical understanding, the focus will be on raising ethical awareness and to nurture a generation capable of using "AI for public good".

In 2025, China started training 6-year-olds in AI, including with use of toys and chatbots. Primary and secondary schools have to conduct at least 8 hours of AI classes annually. Tools are being integrated in education, such as robot tutors for kindergarten to tell stories and test logic.

# Robot Tutors In China

Alpha School is a private K–12 network in the US that uses AI to teach students real-life skills. It uses AI-powered software that compresses subjects into hours and gives feedback, while humans act as facilitators. After academics, students do physical activities, attend workshops, and learn "life skills".

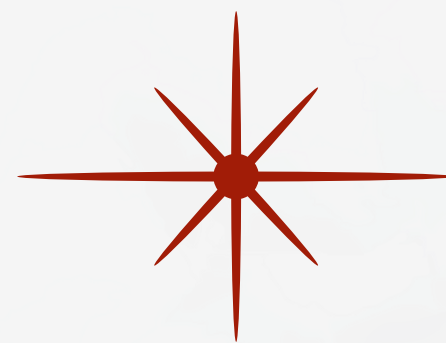


# Singapore's Smart Nation Strategy

Singapore's "Smart Nation" strategy aims to position it as a world leader in AI by 2030. Teachers are being trained at all levels to use AI in education.

An AI-enabled companion is being developed to give feedback and do automated grading, while machine learning systems will identify how students respond to classroom materials.

South Korea spent \$850 million on AI textbooks, only to have the project rolled back in four months.

While it was meant to personalize learning and lighten teachers' workload, a lack of testing and hurried implementation resulted in inaccuracies, technical challenges, and data privacy risks.

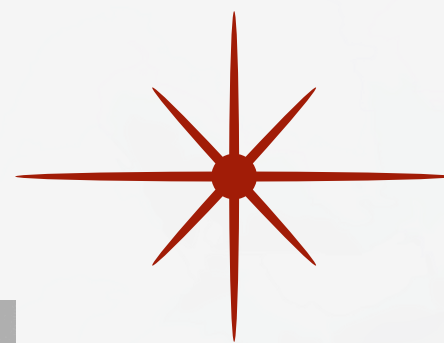
# South Korea's AI-Powered Textbooks

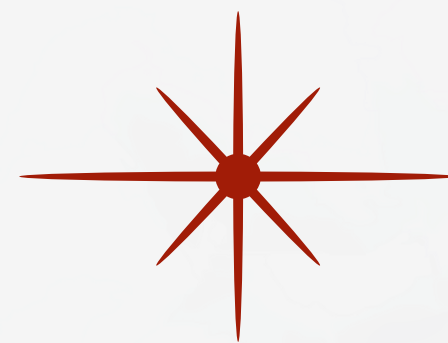

# Estonia-OpenAI Partnership

The Estonian government partnered with OpenAI last year to introduce ChatGPT Edu for secondary school students and teachers. It will provide AI-powered study support, admin task automation, and lesson planning tools.





Finland has added AI literacy to the school curriculum to help children as young as 3 to recognise AI-generated fake news. Media literacy had been a key area of its curriculum for decades. It aims to make children more resistant to propaganda and false claims.
